

## Anthro Weekend Utah 2024 Parental Consent Form

Anthro Weekend Utah (AWU) is an annual convention celebrating the artistic expressions of fans of anthropomorphic artwork. No special concessions are being made for the attendance of minors, but they are welcome to attend, subject to the additional rules below.

AWU is not a supervised environment and is not responsible for the conduct of attendees. The parent understands that their child is in attendance at his or her own risk. The parent agrees to indemnify and hold harmless both AWU and the Davis Conference Center, and both companies' officers, directors, agents, volunteers, and employees with respect to all activities associated with, or any damages arising out of AWU and from any cause of action of any nature arising from their child's participation in AWU.

- AWU is not acting in loco parentis (in place of a parent) for the attending minor. The parent understands that they are responsible for the care, safety, and conduct of their child, whether or not they are attending with their child.

- The parent understands that the minor is expected to follow the convention policies, and the parent is solely responsible for policy violations on the part of the minor. Furthermore, both the minor and an accompanying parent can be ejected together from the convention resulting from policy violations by either party. - Minors under 16 (born after July 19, 2008) can only attend *when supervised by a parent, legal guardian, or temporary alternate guardian (appointed via a notarized Alternate Guardian Form) at all times.*

- Minors between the ages of 16 and 18 (born after July 19, 2006) can attend without parental supervision by supplying this signed and notarized form and a photo ID showing the minor's name and age. The minor must either bring the original signed and notarized copy of this form, or scan and submit it online prior to the convention.
