Staff Updates

Dealer's Den Director: We would like to announce a new Dealer's Den Director for 2026, Luna Starbright! Luna has worked closely with Anthro Weekend Utah (AWU) for several years already. Luna was initially a featured Artist before becoming a Dealer's Den volunteer lead in 2024 and Dealer's Den staff member in 2025. Meaning that many of our prior dealers will already be quite familiar with them as well 😊 We are incredibly thankful to them for being willing to dedicate another year to the AWU Dealer's Den, and they've already been hard at work planning to make 2026 our best year yet! Their incredible attention to detail, as well as their experience as an artist with Dealer's Dens at multiple different conventions, make them a huge asset!

Theme Director: We are thrilled to announce that Milo, our seasoned RPG designer and D&D expert, is transitioning to lead our Theming team! While he steps away as the Dealer's Den Director Milo will continue to spearhead our high-energy dance competition, and has hinted at some awesome puppetry projects in the works. We've loved and appreciated the work he put in as Dealer's Den Director in prior years, and can't wait to see him bring our "Mech vs. Kaiju" theme to life through immersive designs and our signature theme game!

In addition to some main lead changes, we have several new staff volunteers on every internal team, from A/V to Security, meaning AWU 2026 will have the most coverage of any year yet!

We are excited to bring all this new talent into play as we move into the heavy planning phase of our convention!

Policies

AI Policy: We have further defined our AI policy to clarify that we will not accept vendors who sell art created by AI, and reserve the right to remove AI artists from our den, in line with most major art-based conventions around the U.S.

Modern Military & Tactical Gear: To ensure all attendees to Anthro Weekend Utah (AWU) feel safe and comfortable during our 2026 event, we have updated our Dress Code:

1. We kindly ask that you leave realistic modern military, paramilitary, or tactical outfits at home this year. We define "modern" as anything from within the last 30 years.
 - a. Combat or tactical pants are permitted but may be subject to a security sweep.
 - b. Law Enforcement/First Responder uniforms - Any uniform that gives the appearance of an on-duty law enforcement or first responder - is not permitted

Why the change? We truly value the incredible creativity and hard work you put into your characters and costumes. However, given recent events in Utah and safety concerns at other regional conventions, we want to make sure no attendee is ever mistaken for a real-world first responder or uniformed officer.

DJs & Music

The LollapAWUza Music Festival is back for 2026, and we want YOU to take the stage! We are looking for bands and performing groups ready to wow their fellow attendees with a high-energy performance. Performers get a 45-minute set to rock the house and show us what they've got. Upon the successful completion of your set, solo artists will receive \$100, and groups will receive \$200. We are amping up the energy by adding parking lot raves to our 2026 lineup! These outdoor sessions are generally scheduled between 6:00 PM and 9:00 PM (depending on the date), meaning you can catch these high-energy sets and still have plenty of time to head inside for our mainstage DJs. Panels

We are starting the party early, and added a special lineup of Thursday night events to help us kick off the Anthro Weekend Utah (AWU) with a bang!

Faster Check-In: To get you into the action sooner, Ultimate and Basic attendees can now pick up their registration on Thursday night.
